Eastern Suburbs Hockey Club (ESHC) Inc – Easts Hockey Tiger Turf (EHTT)

1. Users Group

- This group is a team of elected representatives from ESHC Inc who meet regularly through the year.
- The role of the group is to develop and monitor use of the facility, attend to routine management and maintenance issues of the facility.

2. Water Based Synthetic Hockey Field

3. Shift Supervisors

- Whenever EHTT is open for association club fixtures, an EHTT team member (Shift Supervisor) will be on duty. Any problems should be reported to the staff on duty at the canteen. The EHTT team member can be identified by a recognisable uniform with the ESHC logo on the front.
- For any other times outside of association fixtures, contact the EHTT Facility Coordinator on 0491 244 134 or via manangement@eastshockey.org.au.

4. Care of Artificial Turf Surface

- The turf carpet surface should be cleared of foreign material after each use.
- · Any blood incidents on the turf surface within boundary wall during hockey activity should be cleaned immediately using disinfectant and supplies under the sink in Tech Bench. See #5 First Aid.
- The following items and practices are prohibited on the pitch turf:
 - 1. Cigarettes, cigars, pipes & vapes.
- 6. High heeled or Stiletto shoes
- 2. Chewing gum or lollies

7. Spitting not permitted on the surface

3. All foodstuffs

- 8. Goalkeepers are not to purposely mark turf
- 4. All drinks other than water/sports drinks 9. All pets from turf areas and within dugouts / tech bench
- 5. Drinking glasses and cans.

5. Acceptable footwear for the EHTT short pile water-based hockey pitch.

- Clean footwear before entering the pitch. Use the shoe brushes and water troughs provided to remove all external matter (stones, dirt, mud, grass etc.) from any footwear.
- Players / officials should wear flat or dimple sole hockey shoes which will generally be trainer-like in their appearance. There must be a minimum of fifteen (15) dimples per shoe. Sprigs must not protrude more than 7mm from the sole of the shoe.
- Goalkeepers may wear boots with moulded rubber / plastic sprigs provided they are trimmed and ground down to a smooth dome to no more than 7mm from the sole. All toe caps or sharp objects such as buckles are to be covered / taped.

6. Prohibited Footwear / Accessories / Food

- Any footwear with metal or hard plastic cleats, studs or blades (less than 15 studs) will likely damage pitch.
- Boots / shoes with leather or metal screw sprigs.
- Hard protective guards for knees and elbows.
- · Bobby hair pins.

7. First Aid

- The First Aid Room is available for the use of fixture hires at EHTT or when requested. The hirer is responsible for the provision of a qualified First Aid Attendant and first aid supplies.
- For individual bookings there is a first aid kit and ICE provided and stored in the Tech Bench for use.
- In an emergency situation on field, contact the EHTT team member (Shift Supervisor) who has an authorised key to unlock padlocks attached to the south access gates of the field for emergencies.
- An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is provided in the Tech Bench above the sink.
- Any individual who sustains a **bleeding injury** shall move or be removed from the turf as soon as possible. Any blood stains on the turf must be reported to the EHTT team to allow for cleaning. Playing or training persons shall not take the field with bleeding wounds or wounds that are not adequately covered. Severely (fresh) blood contaminated clothing is not to be worn on the turf.
- A bucket, cleaning brush, disinfectant and gloves are available under the sink in the Tech Bench cupboard.

8. Training Sessions

- Individual booking fee rates include use of 1/4 field with a sideline goal circle and goal box during off- peak times. Extra turf fees are required if access is required to the turf lights, sprinklers, tech bench or first aid.
- The use of the main circles and goal boxes are only to be used when a full field fixture or training game is being played.
- Management request ALL training sessions to use the east &/or west sideline D circles to help preserve the life of the turf in both main goal circle areas. Check to ensure safety nets are down behind goals to protect facility and general public using these spaces.
- Please carefully move any of the 4 goal boxes to the closest sideline circle allocated for your session.
- Hitting balls against the block wall / wire fence surrounding the field is not permitted.
- Exiting to retrieve any balls hit out of the field is through official entry points only as is returning to the field. Jumping over the fence is not permitted.
- Users are permitted onto the playing surface at the scheduled booking start time.
- Training sessions must be completed no later than 5 minutes prior to the end of the booked time to allow the next Users to begin at the start of that Users booked time.
- All games or training sessions must be booked through the <u>EHTT booking system</u> for individuals, small groups, teams or associations. (See top of page 1, section 2 for online or email booking request information)
- Divisional Coordinators are authorised to ensure T&C's rules are followed.

9. Change Rooms

- Two change rooms are available in the main amenities building opposite the Tech Bench / Dug out areas.
- The change rooms will be made available prior to the commencement of each game / training session. Please ensure these change rooms are left clean and tidy after use. The visitors change room may be made available for private bookings if requested.

10. Dugouts

- Entry restrictions apply to the dugouts except as advised by any official technical officers. Only players, coaches, managers and medical staff may enter.
- Arriving teams cannot enter the dugouts until departing teams have left the field and dugout areas.
- As a safety requirement, all persons must remain in the confines of the dugout during the game. When teams leave the dugout area, they are requested to ensure it is left in a clean and tidy condition.

11. Technical (Tech) Bench

- The tech bench will not be made available unless an official /person will be allocated as responsible for the room from the association who has hired the turf.
- It is requested the tech bench is left in a clean and tidy condition.
- EHTT belongings and first aid kits stored in tech bench must be returned to the allocated cupboard area.

12. Grandstand / Fences

- Jumping over the fences is not permitted.
- Persons playing or training must enter and leave the field at official entry points only.

13. Cancellations

- Cancellations must be in writing and forwarded to EHTT email: management@eastshockey.org.au or via text to the Facility Coordinator 0491 244 134.
- Cancellations will be charged as follows:
 - At least 72 hours' notice given prior to booking date NO CHARGE
 - At least 48 hours' notice given to booking date 25%
 - Less than 48 hours but more than 24 hours' notice given prior to booking date 50%
 - Less than 24 hours' notice given prior to booking date 75%.

14. Entry Gate Guidelines

- No entry gate will be charged for standard fixture games.
- EHTT reserves the right to charge a gate for major events.
- Access into the EHTT shall only be via the designated entry gates.

15. Lighting

- 10-15 minutes after the last game / training session is completed the field lights will be turned off, with only the courtyard, security and car park lighting remaining.
- An exception to the switch off time for turf lights is when fixtures end close to the 10pm auto-off time clock to abide by Brisbane City Council regulations.

16. Watering of Fields and Windy Days

- The EHTT Shift Supervisor is responsible for watering the fields. Authorised personnel are only permitted to water the fields. NB. Weather conditions can dictate sprinkler coverage and may not reach certain turf areas.
- If a team is dissatisfied with the moisture of the turf, contact the EHTT Shift Supervisor on duty.
- On windy days an announcement over the PA may be used to warn spectators of field watering.
- Spectators may get wet from the spray used on the fields before, during and after the game.

17. Lost Property

- All lost property will be held in the EHTT First Aid and storage room area.
- Any lost property items with identification or phone numbers will be contacted.
- Lost Property left unclaimed for more than 30 days will be either discarded or forwarded to an appropriate charity.

18. PA System

- · A 'PA system' is available if required by the hirer.
- Prior arrangement for the use of the PA system should be made at the time of turf booking.

19. EHTT Wet Weather / Unplayable Procedures

- The Association Tech officials are responsible for cancelling their fixtures should the surface/s become unplayable. The Tech officials are responsible for cancelling games if the fields remain playable, but the weather is not conducive to the continuation of that game.
- EHTT Facility Coordinator / Divisional Coordinators are responsible for cancelling training / private bookings should the turf surface become unplayable.
- The field does drain within 20-30minutes if the rain stops.
- Use the 30/30 Lightning Rule. If the time between the lightning flash and the thunder sound is less than 30 SECONDS then play should be suspended, and not resumed until 30 MINUTES after the last thunder (30 seconds relates to 10 kilometres away). EHTT Facility Coordinator / Shift Supervisor will notify the Associations or users of venue closures should weather and conditions change.
- The EHTT Shift supervisor on duty will update the Associations (BHA 0403 042663 or email results@bha.org.au) and (BWHA gm@bwha.com.au) as the inclement weather and conditions change.

20. Smoking at EHTT

- 'No smoking' rules apply at EHTT complex as per Government regulations:
 - Anywhere inside eating and drinking venues such as Easts club room, at the outdoor cafe eating or drinking areas such as viewing deck areas.
- Outdoor smoke-free public areas:
 - No smoking at or within 10 meters of playing and viewing areas during organised under-18 sporting events.

21. Policy on Heat Exhaustion

- Hockey Australia's Extreme Weather Policy including Hot Weather, Lightning, Sun Protection should be referred to. The document is to assist affiliates, their club, coaches and officials and other individuals when considering their duty of care responsibilities.
- All parties must act responsibly with all due care and common sense predominant in making and
 considering the cancellation or modification of hockey fixtures and / or training. Cancellation of events or
 withdrawal from participation may be appropriate even in circumstances falling outside these guidelines.
 When considering cancelling or postponing a specific hockey event. There are many factors that need to be
 considered. This guideline is not intended to address all those factors.

23. Liquor Licensing Rules

- EHTT is a licensed venue and sells alcohol through the canteen and at times, in the club room.
- We encourage the social aspect of our sport and offer the hockey community and players an opportunity to share a drink together during or after the games.
- Any alcohol purchased at EHTT requires players and spectators to consume alcohol in the designated licensed areas.
- Please also note alcohol bought outside the facility cannot be brought in and consumed in a licensed facility.
- A failure to follow these government regulations may result in a fine for the person, the venue, and possible loss of the opportunity to sell alcohol.
